EDUCATION PROGRESSION

Successful completion of the BAcc Accounting will allow you to progress, at either the Paisley or Hamilton campuses of UWS, to YEAR 4 BAcc (Honours) Accounting which covers some of the more contemporary issues in accounting and accounting theory and history and an individual dissertation on an accounting-related issue of your choice.

CAREER PROGRESSION - PROFESSIONAL RECOGNITION

Studying accountancy opens up many opportunities. You can proceed to take professional exams with the main accountancy bodies such as ICAS, ACCA and CIMA for which the BAcc confers maximum professional accreditation and exemptions.
